The purpose of the processing

By providing your email address we are then able to provide you with an email newsletter with updates on the West End Project.

The legal basis for processing

By entering your email and signing up to our newsletter you have given your consent for us to provide you with the email newsletter on the West End Project.

Categories of personal data

By signing up for our newsletter we are collecting only your email address and no further personal data.

The criteria used to decide the retention period
