# SATURDAY WORKING NOTIFICATION – TOTTENHAM COURT ROAD

Dear Business / Resident,

From Saturday 26th January we will be increasing our working hours on Tottenham Court Road to include Saturdays between 9am and 5pm. We are adding these extra hours to ensure that we complete Tottenham Court Road as efficiently as possible.

We aim to complete the majority of the noisy works before 1pm, such as breaking into the ground or cutting paving. Acoustic barriers will be in place to reduce the noise and each area we use for cutting stones will be enclosed in these barriers. While there may still be some noise after 1pm we will aim to keep this to a minimum and focus instead on quieter repaving works.

## **Summary**

- We will be working between 9am and 5pm on each Saturday from the 26th January until the completion of Tottenham Court Road, expected in late spring 2019
- We aim to keep noisy working to before 1pm on Saturdays
- We will be continuing to work Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm

## What is the West End Project?

The West End Project is a £35 million public realm project bringing exciting improvements to the heart of Camden's busy West End.

The project will deliver a bold vision for the future of the area which currently suffers from traffic congestion, narrow pavements, poor air quality and a lack of public spaces.



To help the area to continue to grow and flourish and to address these issues, the project will deliver a number of exciting schemes. This includes making Tottenham Court Road and Gower Street / Bloomsbury Street both two way to traffic. On Tottenham Court Road access will be restricted to buses and cyclists only during key times. On Gower Street / Bloomsbury Street new protected cycle lanes will be added, in addition to a new pedestrian crossing in front of UCL. New public spaces will be created in Princes Circus and Alfred Place.

### What will it look like?

Bespoke high quality changes will be delivered in each location. To give you an idea of what these changes will look like, here is a projected image of Tottenham Court Road. After the works are completed this road will be two way to traffic with some sections restricted to buses and cyclists only from 8am to 7pm Monday to Saturday.

New paving and road surface will be laid using high quality material and the historic lamp posts restored.
