Windmill Square – Tottenham Court Road New pocket park

Dear Resident / Business,

As part of the West End Project, the works to create an improved public space at Windmill Square on Tottenham Court Road is due to start on Monday 17th October 2022. Windmill Square is the space on Tottenham Court Road between the junctions of Percy Street and Windmill Street.

We have already added the new widened granite pavement to this area, now we will be creating new places to sit alongside planting to complement the new and existing trees. These changes will improve the look at feel of the space even more, provide a new space to stop and relax and increase the local biodiversity of the area.

Key information

- We will be working on the pavement space between Percy Street and Windmill Street
- Access will be maintained throughout the works
- The contractors will be Volker Highways
- Working hours: Mon Fri: 8am 6pm and as needed Saturday: 8am 1pm
- All work to the area is expected to be completed by the 4th November 2022.

What is the West End Project?

The West End Project is a £35 million public realm project bringing exciting improvements to the heart of Camden's busy West End. The project is delivering a bold vision for the future of the area, which suffered from traffic congestion, road safety issues, narrow pavements, poor air quality and a lack of public spaces.

To help the area to continue to grow and flourish and to address these issues, the project is delivering a number of exciting changes. This



includes having made Tottenham Court Road, Gower Street and Bloomsbury Street both two way to traffic.

On Tottenham Court Road access to some areas is now restricted to buses and cyclists only during key times. On Gower Street / Bloomsbury Street new cycle lanes have been added, in addition to a new pedestrian crossing in front of UCL. A new public space is being created in Princes Circus following the completion of a new park in Alfred Place, the rejuvenation of Whitfield Gardens and pocket parks along Tottenham Court Road.

What will the changes look like? Bespoke high quality changes are being delivered in each location. Above is an image of Whitfield Gardens which has been rejuvenated as part of the project.
